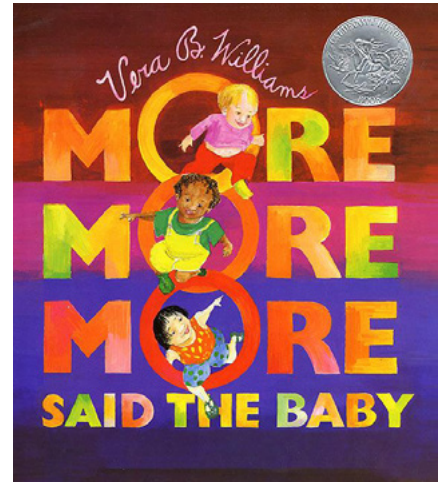


“More More More,” Said the Baby

For Children Birth to Age 3

Questions

- Lots of people love you! Who can you think of that loves you? (You might make a list like: Mama loves you. Daddy loves you. Big Sister loves you. Grandpa Joe loves you.)
- How do you think the little boy feels when his daddy scoops him up like that?
- Do you remember when Grammy came? She kissed you like that, too! How did you feel when you had Grammy kisses?
- Little Bird is very sleepy. Sometimes you get sleepy like that, too! When you get sleepy like that I love to snuggle you. How do you feel when I snuggle you like that?

Activities

Make Your Own Story


Think about what your baby loves. Does she love to be kissed on her neck? Spun in a circle? Whatever it is, do it with her and then say (together if she has words), “More, more, more!” and then do it again. Pass her off to another adult that loves her and do some other thing like tickling her toes, bouncing her gently, or chasing her through the house. More, more, more!

Let Your Baby Do It

Using a baby doll, have your child act out the story. He can be the daddy and say, “More, more, more” as he snuggles his baby close.
